



**Dear Parents and Care Givers,**

Wow, it is hard to believe we are into Week 7 and nearly halfway through the 2016 academic year! 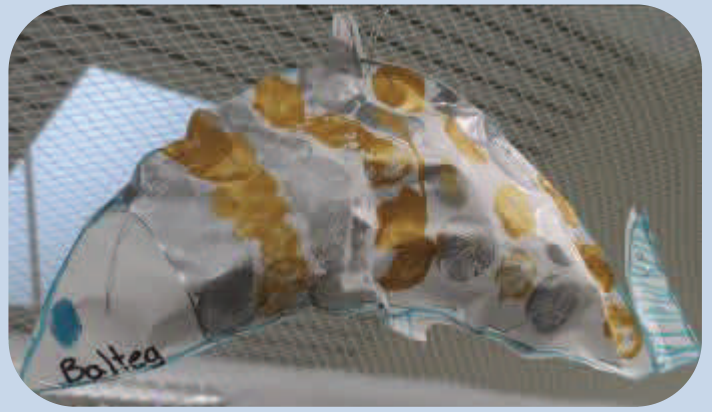
