On Thursday, 1 December a select group of students from Year 3 to Year 6 were invited to join other primary schools for a STEM event at Southern River College:



## **P&C NEWS**

CANTEEN - The canteen will be open Friday 9 December during recess and lunch. Orders can be made via QuickCliq or over the counter. Children in Years 1-6 can purchase snack items at recess and lunch (cash only). The canteen will also be open on the last day of school (Thursday 15 December) at recess for the purchase of snack items (cash only).

**Unfortunately, in 2023 the canteen will not reopen.** This has been a very difficult decision to make and it is one that the P&C has not made lightly. Apart from declining sales, the P&C now only has around 8 active members and two, including myself, whose children are now both in high school, will not be involved next year. It takes quite a bit of work to even maintain the operation of the canteen and uniform shop let alone anything else, and so in 2023, the P&C will continue to manage uniform sales but rather than operate a canteen, it will re-focus it's efforts on fundraising for the school.

UNIFORM SHOP - SPECIAL SUMMER ITEM ORDERS - A 'Uniform Order for Summer Items' form was sent home with students this week and was also emailed to families. Completed forms must be returned to the classroom teacher or the Admin office by Monday, 12 December at the latest. Please do not send any payment to school with these order forms - payment will only be accepted on the collection dates (see below). The Uniform Shop will be open for payment and collection of these special orders only on:

Monday, 30 January 2023 - 9am to 3pm - Kindy to Year 2 students Tuesday, 31 January 2023 - 9am to 3pm - Year 3 to Year 6 students

If you have more than one child and their Year Group falls on two different days you will be able to collect multiple orders on the one day. You will be able to pay via cash or EFTPOS.
