Dear parent and carers,

As a special reward activity for the end of the term and end of the 2022 school year, on **Tuesday 13th December** students will have the opportunity to wear free dress with a colour fun activity planned for the afternoon (**1.40pm** onwards on the **school oval**).

The colour fun event was the most selected event idea from the many student consultation events held throughout the year and is where coloured powder and water is thrown onto students as they navigate an obstacle course.

At present, only a very small number of students will be ineligible to attend as a result of losing their good standing. These students will be advised directly and will complete alternative activities with school staff.

Parents are most welcome to spectate for this event however must sign students out with class teachers if any students are required to leave prior to 2.40pm.

Parent can access the oval via the community gates (on the oval itself) or via the side gate next to the undercover area which will be open for this particular event.

What to bring:

• Clothing that you are comfortable with students getting covered in coloured powder. The powder is fully soluble in water however there is a small risk of staining if not washed following the event.

• A plastic bag. The bag can be used to store the clothing once used in the colour fun activity.

• **Change in clothing.** This is important if you want your child to change prior to heading home. We recommend a change of clothing in a sealed plastic bag so that clothing worn for the event can be stored securely.

• A hat. Students are permitted to wear a non GPS branded cap/hat on this day.

During the event, students will bring their backpacks onto the oval with corridors closed and all students will use the senior toilets which will be supervised by school staff.

At the event conclusion, students will be directed to exit the event via the many gates around the school (as per normal).
