Local Road Updates:

As part of the Rail Revitalisation Program, the Public Transport Authority will be undertaking work to renew the pedestrian and vehicle level crossings at Fremantle Road, Stalker Road/Main Street and Dorothy Street. These works require road closures at the level crossings. Access to local businesses will be maintained. Pedestrians will be diverted to the nearest pedestrian level crossings.



To minimise the length of the closure, 24-hour works will be taking place. Traffic management and detours will be in place as per the below schedules and images.



Dorothy Street crossing closed:

Monday 11 November to Sunday 24 November 2024

Stalker Road / Main Street crossing closed: Monday 25th October to Sunday 1 December 2024



Fremantle Road crossing closed:

Monday 2 December to Sunday 14 December 2024

Class Placements:

Class Placements Planning for 2025 is very much underway with provisionally planned classes to be prepared shortly. We are still inviting parent requests for class placements in 2025. Requests for class placements will only be considered if they are made in writing, based on the specific educational needs of your child and close on Wednesday 20th November 2024. Such requests can be made via email: gosnells.ps@education.wa.edu.au or by dropping a letter to the front office. When considering a class placement request, please be mindful that our teachers may not be in the same class or year levels they are currently as some changes to this is always necessary. A common request is for example when you have two children in the same year level that you may want them to be kept together or apart. It is important to note the complexities involved in establishing classrooms and that parent requests are one of a number of pieces of information considered when arriving at class placement decisions. If you have previously made a request in the past year, please resubmit if you'd like this to be continued for 2025.

This notification will greatly assist us to plan classes for the new year and prepare any information to share with the new school too.

Grant Success:

Last Friday we had confirmation that we were again successful in our submission for a grant. This time for a Solar Schools grant.

This grant will unlock an opportunity to further reduce our energy costs with the installation of a new solar power array over the next 6 months. All savings will be reinvested into upgrading our classrooms with LED lighting, further allowing us to divert more of our funds to where it is needed most.
