Dear Gosnells Primary School Community,

What a great year we had at Gosnells Primary School! As 2024 draws to a close, it is important for us all to reflect on the many successes of this year and the great opportunities that will arise as we prepare for the 2025 school year.

Next week we will meet for our Colour Run, Year 6 Graduation ceremony and Celebrating Gosnells events. Each of these special events will showcase the amazing year we have had at GPS whilst also acknowledging the passage of our Year 6 students as they transition into high school next year.

Colour Run:

As a special reward activity for the end of the term and end of the 2024 school year, on **Monday**, **9th December** Kindy to Year 6 students have the opportunity to wear free dress with a Colour Run planned for the afternoon (approximately **1:40pm** onwards on the **school oval**).

The colour fun event was again the most selected event idea from the many student consultation events held throughout the year and is where coloured powder and water is thrown on to students as they navigate an obstacle course.

At present, only a very small number of students will be ineligible to attend as a result of losing their good standing. These students will be advised directly and will complete alternative activities with school staff.

Parents are most welcome to spectate for this event; however, must sign students out with class teachers if any students are required to leave prior to 2:40pm. Parents can access the oval via the community gates (on the oval itself) or via the side gate next to the undercover area which will be open for this particular event.

What to bring:

Clothing that you are comfortable with students getting covered in coloured powder. The powder is fully soluble in water; however, there is a small risk of staining if not washed following the event.

Change of clothing: This is important if you want your child to change prior to heading home. We recommend a change of clothing in a sealed plastic bag so that clothing worn for the event can be stored securely.

A hat: Students are permitted to wear a non GPS branded cap/hat on this day.
